Update on projects	<p><u>An update on the budget of the GRAAIL project was given.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 companies have been approached <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ ALK USA and HAL Allergen not interested ○ This leaves 4 companies who can be involved ○ The CRF budget for 5yrs is approx. 1.8 million Euros ○ Academic proposal is in the process <p><u>The methodology of GRAAIL was discussed.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently based on the French AIT registry • It was suggested that the GRAAIL registry could be similar to ISAR by combining national AIT registries into a generalized and standardized dataset <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Would be cheaper ○ Have opportunity to publish at international level • Countries should be chosen based on their common use of AIT, e.g. Germany, France, Spain & Italy • It was suggested to include physicians in the registry <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Input of physicians from the beginning of building registry to verify PROs



	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Example with allergic asthma: no benefit for AIT – need specific physiological measures○ But AIT is more straight forward than asthma:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Baseline characteristics well known▪ Already sorted by physician <p><u>The involvement of EAACI in GRAAIL project was discussed.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Duplicity of AIT Registries should be avoided.• REG aim to work together with EAACI to join forces re request of financial support to industry.• Need to set up a formal agreement with EAACI• EAACI would be slow to set a registry up, where REG would be focused and quicker due to smaller size• Walter & Nikos are trying to promote the project to EAACI• Expect to be cooperative
