<b>1</b>	<b>Update on current projects</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Validation of the concept of control of COPD in clinical practice.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Pilot database study has been accepted for publication in <i>COPD: Journal of COPD</i>.</li> <li>○ Multicenter, international and prospective study aimed to validate the concept of control in COPD and its implications for clinical practice.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>339 enrolled, 324 (95.6 %) completed baseline visit. 242 patients have withdrawn after the screening visit. Follow up visits are underway (265 (78.2 %) have completed 1st follow up to date). Data collection should be completed by Nov 2018.</p>
<b>2</b>	<b>Ideas for future projects</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Implications of ICS withdrawal in the real-life management of COPD (Real-life WISDOM).</b> Is there still interest in continuing this project? Dirkje Postma has now retired, so a new lead investigator is required.</li> <li>• <b>Modern epidemiology of alpha-1-antitrypsin deficiency (AATD) in the UK.</b> (Lead investigator Joan Soriano). Protocol written. First the plan is to conduct a pilot study which would just look at those with AATD diagnosis, no matched comparisons. We have an old dataset, which was to be used for the pilot study. There was originally no interest from funders. Is there still interest in pursuing this pilot study?</li> </ul>
