<b>1</b>	<b>Update on current projects</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Evaluation the comparative effectiveness of adding antibiotics to usual care (oral steroids) for the management of asthma exacerbations.</li> <li>It was explained that this was on hold until Sarah Lucas returns.</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<b>Prioritisation of future work</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The potential to investigate the stepdown of ICS was discussed. It was acknowledged that funding for this may be difficult. One way may be to find a student who was willing to work on the project.</li> </ul> <p>Action: Naomi to contact Steve regarding the feasibility of running this study.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>PeaRL was discussed, including the need for ontology and a network analysis approach. The discussion to inform this will occur on the Saturday of the REG summit. A facilitator for this and the Delphi studies will be required. The systematic reviews, Delphis and ontology research will run in parallel with the end goal of creating evidence-based guidelines. Many organisations are already involved, but it is crucial to make sure they remain engaged for the guidelines to be accepted generally.</li> </ul> <p>Action: Naomi and Nikos to prepare a proposal so that a budget for this study can be created.</p>
