New project possibilities	The group discussed a potential project: "Prospective, observational, multinational study on the effectiveness of AIT in moderate allergic asthma"  • Challenge: Exacerbation is the primary outcome, but rare event.  • Which to assess? Hospitalizations? Emergency room visits?  • Suggested also time off work/school  • Suggested also annualized exacerbation rate (not no. of exacerbations)  • Suggested maybe exacerbation is a secondary outcome  • Challenge: search for the balance between how to minimize the effort/time required to participate by physician / patient and capture the maximum of data possible.  • Challenge: criteria for how symptomatic patients are. e-DASTHMA is an interesting tool. Reimbursement criteria vary by country.



<u>Challenge</u> : Definition of moderate asthma: must go beyond 'those who are on ICS-LABA' as this is nowadays not only prescribed in GINA Step 3/4.
<ul> <li>Must exclude severe and differentiate between mild and moderate.</li> <li>Including spirometry would be much recommended</li> <li>Include quality of life</li> <li>Disease uncontrolled on just a steroid dose?         Medium dose?         <ul> <li>Need a threshold, e.g., certain VAS score for period of time before starting</li> </ul> </li> <li>Need to capture upper airways symptoms – VAS nasal/eye symptoms</li> <li>Challenge – availability differs country to country e.g., spirometry</li> <li>Challenge – If study is not a registry (instead a prospective trial), then what is a suitable control?</li> <li>Suggested patient self-controlled case series (i.e., patients used as on control pre- / post-AIT</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>A new draft of a research proposal will be developed and send to a project steering committee for refinement and further discussion.</li> </ul>
