New project possibilities	<ul> <li>The group discussed a potential project on time to biologics in severe asthma patients.         <ul> <li>Brett outlined the CHRONICLE study.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Potential difficulties involved in the study were outlined:         <ul> <li>Source of data – exacerbations not in primary care database – HESS or ISAR, or is database unnecessary?</li> <li>Control group – use patients as own controlself controlled case series to reduce sample size issues.</li> <li>Risk of 'hindsight' bias – Some individuals delayed to start biologics are milder than those hospitalized.</li> <li>Definition of severe asthma to use – uncontrolled on later GINA steps.</li> <li>Time to 1st biologic as a key measure – time from when? 1st asthma diagnosis / exacerbation?</li> <li>There may be overlap with an ISAR project.</li> <li>Model assumptions – assume patients fully adherent, contrast with sub-adherent.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
