Update on projects	 The Novartis Breezhaler project was discussed. Final proposal has been developed and submitted to Novartis. Additional documentation provided by Novartis is being completed. 	
Prioritisation of projects and future direction	 The future of a possible REOM device project was discussed. Ron outlined his projects using the REOM device and associated interactive dashboard, highlighting the need for home monitoring post-COVID, and sought suggestions for expansion and further funding. It was agreed upon that seeking an EU Horizon grant would be the best grant (€4-5 million), but this needs to be led by an EU / UK institution not a company, so cannot be lead by REG. It was suggested that a co-professorship with Ron and an EU / UK university would work. The grant proposal would take months of work to ensure all different work packages in the grant are covered.
